Day 1: Start your day with a visit to Anthony Thomas Candy in Columbus, OH. Experience candy making from start to finish. Enjoy an included lunch in the Historic German Village. After lunch you will have a Guided Columbus City Tour. Visit the Franklin Park Conservatory and Botanical Gardens. From award-winning gardens to compelling art exhibits, you're sure to find something that speaks to you. In the Blooms & Butterflies Garden, you will see hundreds of brightly colored butterflies of all sizes. Stop and shop at Mrs. Turbo's Cookies a retro 50's pinup themed bakery, famous for delivering all-natural, gourmet treats made from scratch, including their delicious whoopie pies!

Included dinner tonight with **Irish Wake Entertainment**. We will look at many of the customs associated with the wake and how it came to have a wild reputation (think of it as a going away party).

Day 2: Start your day with an Irish Pennywhistle Experience. Discover the magic of this simple and lyrical instrument. Visit the Kelton House Museum and Garden. Kelton House was an Underground Railroad stop. Sophia Kelton lets you in on the family's secret. Next stop is the Ohio's Governor's Residence and Heritage Garden. The residence is a beautiful historic home filled with examples of Ohio art and industry. The Heritage Garden residence gardens give visitors a unique glimpse into the natural history and current status of Ohio's environmental landscape.

Before starting for home, enjoy a photo op at **Topiary Garden Park** in the Discovery District. Topiary Garden Park sits on the remnants of the Old Deaf School Park. Georges Seurat's Famous post impressionist painting, *Sunday Afternoon on the Island of La Grande Jatte*, is created in topiary. This "landscape of a painting of a landscape" consists of 54 topiary people, eight boats, three dogs, a monkey, a cat and a real pond. The largest figure is 12' tall. (B/L)
