Day 1: Travel to Ohio and visit the National Museum of Cambridge Glass. Learn about the pride and dedication of the artisans who produced the elegant handmade glassware still treasured today. Stroll through colorful, sparkling displays led by friendly guides! Don't forget the gift shop.

Visit the America's Packard Museum in Dayton. The Museum is located inside an original Packard dealership. America's Packard Museum manages the largest public collection of Packard automobiles and memorabilia in the world. It contains over fifty cars, thousands of parts, and a research library. Overnight in Dayton, Ohio. (D)

Day 2: Enjoy a visit to the National Museum of the United States Air Force, located on the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base in Dayton, Ohio. It is a national treasure and is promoted as the largest and oldest military aviation museum in the world. This newly enlarged facility traces the history of flight from early ballooning to space travel.

Included in its exhibits are U.S. and foreign military planes, space capsules, and early Presidential planes. The museum features more than 360 aerospace vehicles, missiles, and thousands of artifacts amid more than 19 acres of indoor exhibit space.

There is also a theater, cafeteria, and large gift shop. (B)
